



## **Ammunition Recommendation**

### **PAR1 “Pocket AR” & PAK1 “Pocket AK” Pistols**

Heizer Defense recommends using only US Factory Manufactured Premium .223 Ammunition in the PAR1 “Pocket AR” Pistol & Premium 7.62x39 Ammunition in the PAK1 “Pocket AK” Pistol.

Heizer Defense “Pocket” Pistols were tested and appear capable of firing different brands of ammunition with differing bullet grains; however, while other ammunition may perform in the pistol, the use of lower-quality ammunition may result in a “stuck” or “sticky” barrel (barrel hard to open) or “stuck” or “sticky” cartridge (cartridge hard to remove). If this occurs, please perform the following steps:

1<sup>st</sup>: Point the pistol in a safe direction and pull the trigger 3 – 4 times. This will usually be enough to allow the barrel to open.

2<sup>nd</sup>: If this fails to “unstick” the barrel, apply downward pressure on top of barrel, while pushing thumb latch forward. You may have to even strike the top of the barrel (with no-mar object) to loosen round.

3<sup>rd</sup>: A cleaning rod may also be needed to remove cartridge.

4<sup>th</sup>: Make sure chamber and barrel are clean and oil free. (Refer to Care & Cleaning section of Owner’s Manual page 19.)

5<sup>th</sup>. Finally, try a different brand of ammunition if having issues.

Note: please allow for a break-in period of at least 30 rounds and also avoid lacquer coated rounds.
